A REPORT ON NSS ACTIVITIES OF ANDHRA UNIVERSITY FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

VANAM MANAM PROGRAMME

Government of Andhra Pradesh has organized massive plantation programme "Vanam Manam" to make Andhra Pradesh state as "Haritandhrapradesh". The Government of Andhra Pradesh planted 1,00,00,000 saplings on single day i.e., on 1st July, 2017 in all the 13 districts in the entire State of Andhra Pradesh. As part of this initiative the Government of A.P. gave directions to all the public representatives, Government Departments, NGO's and others, etc. to participate in the "Vanam-Manam" programme on 1st July, 2017.

In this connection, all the NSS Units of Andhra University jurisdiction implemented the programme with cooperation from all the government departments, NGO's and other concerned. On 1st July, 2017, all the NSS volunteers of the respective NSS Units of Andhra University area involved and planted saplings in their respective adopted villages/slums.

WORLD POPULATION DAY CELEBRATIONS

The Andhra University NSS Cell organized a massive rally in connection with World Population Day in and around the Andhra University campus with 450 NSS volunteers from different colleges of the Visakhapatnam city on 11.07.2017.
