Announces a new cohort program STEM Course

MS in Business Analytics (Duration 2 years)

One year Online at Andhra University: Technical support by Andhra University School of International Business

Eligibile to complete M.S in Business Analytics in second year at The University of Scranton, Pennysylvania, USA after completion of the 1st year online Graduate Certificate course with GPA 3.0 or greater.

Eligibility Criteria:

Completed undergraduate study with a minimum 3.00 GPA (3 years degree (i.e.,B.Com, B.Sc& BBA) or 4 years degree (i.e., any B.E/B.Tech/B.Arch, B.Pharmacy & MBA) with 2.75 GPA out of 4)

Proficient in English with TOEFL iBT (a minimum score of 80), the IELTS (a minimum score of 6.5), an official Pearson Test of English (PTE) Academic score of 53 or a Duolingo score of 105.

A GRE or GMAT score is not required for admission to this program. AU students will enrol on an individual basis, directly with Scranton, for the on-campus M.S. in Business Analytics program.

Students successfully completing the four courses in the Graduate Certificate in Business Analytics cohort program with a GPA of 3.0 or greater in Andhra University will be admitted to the Master of Science in Business Analytics program taught in Scranton, Pennsylvania U.S.A. This degree can be completed in two additional semesters (18 credit hours) beyond the certificate program.

<u>Note:</u> Students without business knowledge in statistics, management science, and information systems may require one or more 1-credit foundational courses (i.e. MBA 501A, MBA 501B, and MBA 501C).

Fee Structure:

The University of Scranton 2022-2023 per student tuition fees and fee expense for the 12-credit online certificate cohort program is \$6250. Note: tuition for students pursuing the M.S. in Business Analytics in the second year in \$965 per credit. Students will be required to provide proof of finances that includes educational and living expenses as per U.S. government regulations.

- 4. Academic Transcripts
- 5. Three letters of reference.
- 6. Scranton has sole discretion to make admissions, dismissal, and enrollment decisions.
