- ii. Candidates must enclose self- attested copies of concerned certificates from onwards. In absence of the attested copies of Mark sheets/Certificates etc., application will be considered incomplete and applicants may not be called for interview.
- iii. The Last Date for receipt of Application is 25-11-2025 at 5.00 PM
- iv. Applicant must produce original testimonials, certificates and other documents at the time of interview, if called.
- v. - vi. A candidate who knowingly or will-fully furnish incorrect or false particulars or suppresses material Information, will be disqualified and if appointed will be liable to dismissal from service, without notice.
- vii. If any additional information is to be given, the information in separate sheet should be attached.
- viii. The candidate must possess the required qualifications at the time of last date fixed for receipt of applications by post in the notification by the University i.e 25-11-2025 at 5.00 p.m.
- ix. The persons belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Other Minorities and other weaker sections of the society may be given preference in filling the above posts.
- x. Candidates, if called for interview, will have to come at their own expense.
- xi. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill any post or to alter the number of posts in any cadre or in any / all the subject or make any amendments, as per the guidelines of UGC.
- xii. The knowledge of English is compulsory

- xx. Mention only the period of research experience, excluding the number of years spent for acquiring Ph.D. Provide relevant experience documents.
- xxi. The teaching experience should include full time experience only. Part-time, daily wage, visiting / Guest Faculty experience will not be counted while calculating the total experience.
- xxii. The candidates will be called for interview, wherever applicable, by the University on the recommendations of Screening/Scrutiny Committee.

I. Essential Qualifications for Assistant Professor

Essential Qualifications:

- A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subjects (Master's Degree in Demography / Population Studies / Statistics / Biostatistics / Economics / Mathematics / Sociology, social Work / Psychology, Anthropology, Geography. Persons with P.G. Degree other than Demography / Population Studies should have completed a minimum one year regular course in Demography / Population Studies at a recognized institution / University) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
 - ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances /Bye-Laws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/ AP-SLET/ AP-SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/ funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

OR

B. The Ph.D. degree in relevant subject from a foreign university /institution with a ranking among the top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii)the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).
