INSTRUCTIONS TO THE COORDINATORS / STUDENT TEACHERS

- Each student teacher should complete 20 lessons of Teaching Practice (5 lessons in Intensive Teaching & 15 lessons in Block & Teaching) for 6th & 7th classes and 20 lessons (5 lessons in Intensive Teaching & 15 lessons in Block Teaching) for 8th & 9th classes in each methodology. (Total 40 lessons in each methodology).
- During Intensive Teaching Practice in first spell for 10 days, each student teacher needs to complete 10 lessons in each methodology out of which 5 lessons in 6th & 7th classes and 5 lessons in 8th & 9th classes under the supervision of respective methodology teacher educators of College of Education. Every lesson is to be signed by respective methodology teacher.
- During Intensive Teaching Practice, each student teacher is required to observe 10 lessons from peer group in each methodology and submit the same as Observation Record.
- The remaining 30 lessons in each methodology should be completed in Block Teaching out of which 15 lessons in 6th & 7th classes and 15 lessons in 8th & 9th classes under the supervision of concerned subject teachers in the School. Every lesson is to be signed by respective subject teacher.
- After completion of Block teaching, the student teacher should get a certificate signed by School Head Master / Head Mistress with school stamp.
- The student teachers should wear white uniform during teaching practice and University Practical Examination.
- Every student teacher should prepare a lesson plan and proper Teaching Learning Material during teaching practice.
