Subj: - Introduction of Correspondence Courses in the
Andhra University.

Sir,

With reference to your letter No. UI-3554/70 dated the 27th July, 1971 on the above subject, I am directed to say that on the recommendations of the Committee (copy enclosed) appointed by the University Grants Commission to examine the proposal of your University for introducing correspondence courses in Arts and Commerce at the undergraduate level, the Commission has agreed to provide assistance upto Rs. 5 lakhs for a period of four years on the usual sharing basis. It may please be noted that assistance towards the construction of the building will be on 50:50 sharing basis. The Commission's assistance towards the scheme for the introduction of correspondence courses will be available to the University outside the fourth plan allocation of the University.

The other relevant conditions governing the Commission's grant will be the same as already communicated to the University in connection with the implementation of the Fourth Plan Development Schemes.

The Commission desired that the proposal of the University for postgraduate courses by correspondence may be taken up after the report of the expert committee for formulation of guidelines for such courses is available.

The University may please acknowledge the receipt of letter and convey the acceptance of conditions attached to the grant.
