### Exceptions to Pacta Sunt Servanda

- New states as a result of revolt
- Treaty obligation which are related to property ceded or merged
- In applicability of the treaty due to fundamental change ( Art 62) *clausula rebus sic stantibus*



### PACTA SUNT SERVANDA

- States are bound to fulfill in good faith the obligations assumed by them in good faith .
- Article 26, VCLT
- "Every treaty in force is binding upon the parties and must be performed by them in good faith"
- Article 27,
- " No justification of failure to comply with the international law"



### Vienna Convention on Law of Treaties (VCLT), 1980

- Jan 27, 1980
- Preamble, 8 parts, 85 Articles
- Non – sovereign states and vassal states can also be the part of the treaty
- Non-Sovereign States Territories
- of sovereign states are not sovereign states in their own right.
- A **vassal state** is any state that is subordinate to another. The vassal in these cases is the ruler, rather than the state itself. Being a vassal most commonly implies providing military assistance to the dominant state when requested to do so; it sometimes implies paying tribute, but a state which does so is better described as a tributary state.
- Article 2 and Article 3 of VCLT , 1980 have explained what is a treaty is .

### MAJORITY RULES

- Appointment of representation by contracting states
- Negotiation and adoption – 2/3 majority
- Signature and ratification
- Assertion or adherence
- Entry into force
- Registration and publication



In addition, it regulates the registration of **Overseas Citizen of India Cardholders (OCIs)** and their rights. An OCI is entitled to some benefits such as a **multiple-entry, multipurpose lifelong visa to visit India**.


**ILLEGAL MIGRANTS:** An illegal migrant is prohibited from acquiring Indian citizenship. An illegal immigrant is a foreigner who either enters India illegally, i.e., without valid travel documents, like a visa and passport, or enters India legally, but stays beyond the time period permitted in their travel documents. An illegal migrant can be prosecuted in India and deported or imprisoned.

- In September 2015 and July 2016, the government exempted certain groups of illegal migrants from being imprisoned or deported. These are illegal migrants who came into India from **Afghanistan, Bangladesh, or Pakistan on or before December 31, 2014, and belong to the Hindu, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi, or Christian religious communities.**

# Introduction of warrant, offences, arrest and bail in crpc



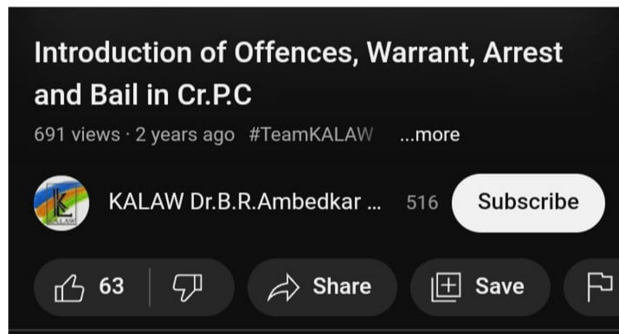
## Cognizable & non cognizable offence

### Cognizable

- All serious offences are cognizable.
- Offences under laws other than the Indian Penal Code which are punishable with 3 years imprisonment or more.
- Murder, waging war against state.
- Police officer may arrest without warrant.
- Police is under legal duty to investigate without directions from magistrate.
- Cognizable offences are considered public wrongs & therefore prosecution of offender is left to the initiative and efforts of state.

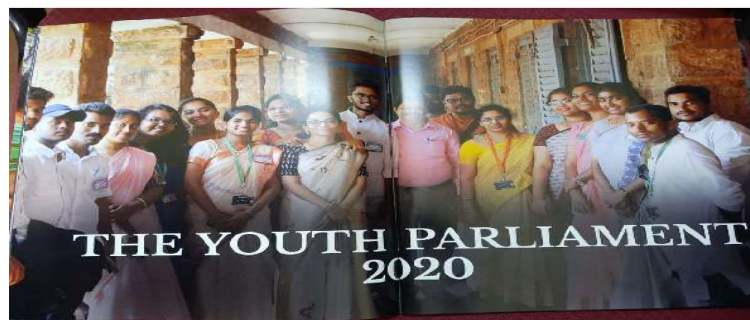
### Non-cognizable

- Non-cognizable offences are more trivial & less serious than cognizable ones.
- Those punishable with less than 3 yrs or with fine.
- Absconding to avoid service of summons, giving false information to public officer.
- Police has no authority to arrest without warrant.
- Police have neither duty nor power to investigate such offences without authority given by magistrate.
- Non-cognizable offences are considered private wrongs and therefore prosecution of offender is left to the initiative & efforts of private persons.





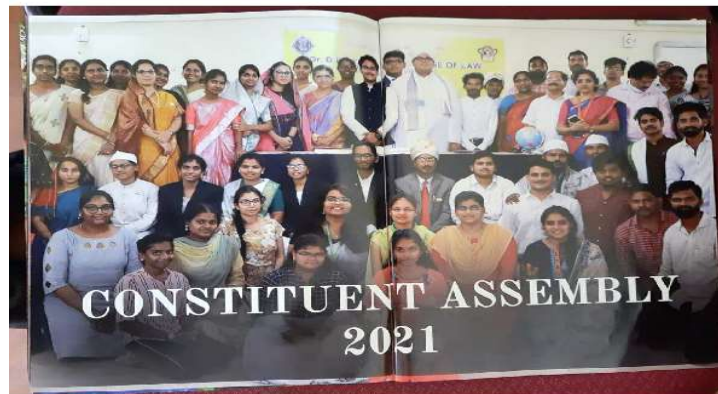
